The Tony Dobell Chair in Pediatric Surgery

In 2012, funds raised by The Montreal Children's Hospital Foundation's Golf Tournament were used to create the Tony Dobell Chair in Pediatric Surgery. The chair was named for Dr. Anthony Dobell, a pioneer in both adult and pediatric cardiovascular thoracic surgery and one of the first physicians in Canada to perform open-heart surgery.

Academic chairs like these are important tools for recruiting and retaining the best and brightest minds in the field of medicine. The Tony Dobell Chair is held by pediatric surgeon Dr. Christo Tchervenkov, an internationally-renowned leader in the field of pediatric cardiology.



Dr. Tchervenkov is a Professor of Surgery at McGill University. He is also the Director of the McGill Centre of Excellence for Congenital Heart Disease and the Director of Cardiovascular Surgery at the Montreal Children's Hospital. He serves on the Councils of the Congenital Heart Surgeons' Society and the European Congenital Heart Surgeons Association, and is the Founding President of the World Society for Pediatric and Congenital Heart Surgery.
